Project Measures: With the adoption of the National Renewable Energy Action Plan (NREAP), Bosnia and Herzegovina has increased its compliance with the requirements of Directive 2009/28/EC. It is foreseen that the binding renewable energy target will be exceeded, reaching 43% in 2020.

Elektroprivreda Republike Srpske (ERS), a state-owned power company organized as holding in Republika Srpska, Bosnia and Herzegovina and the second-largest power utility in Bosnia and Herzegovina. ERS's subsidiaries are responsible for the production and distribution of electrical energy in the entity of Republika Srpska (RS) in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

ERS is now interested in expanding their generation capacity by implementation of wind farms.

The main focus of the programme is to increase the share of Renewable Energies in Bosnia and Herzegovina's power system and to improve the economic situation in the region. For this purpose, a Feasibility Report has been prepared for Wind Farm Hrgud (WF Hrgud).

Against this background, ERS is supported by the Federal Republic of Germany through KfW Development Bank under the Bosnia and Herzegovina–German Financial Cooperation. The total costs of the planned project WF Hrgud are estimated at 65 million EUR. Up to 60 million EUR would be provided by KfW as a loan to ERS covering the costs for the wind turbines, foundations, electrical network on site, substations on site, roads as well as for transmission and grid connection costs. The WF Hrgud project is still in the preparation phase.

The Federal Government of Germany provides a grant of 200.000 EUR as co-financing for the ESIA including optional services.

Requested Services: This advertisement refers to the services to be rendered and financed in the framework of project preparation. The Consultant shall support ERS in the successful preparation of the WF Hrgud project.

The duties shall comprise but are not limited to assistance in the following areas:

- Preparation of an Environmental and Social Scoping Statement (ESSS-report).

- Preparation of an ESIA-report.
- Development of an Environmental and Social Management Plan (ESMP).
- Development of a Stakeholder Engagement Plan (SEP).
- Development of a Land Acquisition Plan/ Livelihood Restoration Plan (LAP/ LRP) and if applicable a Resettlement Action Plan (RAP).
- Support during Consultation with local Population.

The Tender Procedure is subject to the regulations contained in the „Guidelines for Assignment of Consultants in Financial Cooperation with Partner Countries“ (see www.kfw-entwicklungsbank.de). The contract will be awarded to an independent Consultant firm with proven experience of at least 5 years in the renewable energies and environmental sector (performance of complete Environmental and Social Impact Assessments). Experience in Bosnia and Herzegovina and in the region as well as a minimum annual turnover of 500,000 EURO is required.
